

A14 Mobile Visitor Centre will be in Over on Monday the 11th November.



The £1.5bn A14 Cambridge to Huntingdon improvement scheme includes a major new 12-mile bypass to the south of Huntingdon between Swavesey and Brampton and upgrades to 21 miles of the A14. Work started officially in November 2016 and the new road will be open to traffic by the end of 2020.

Other works include:

- Widening the A1 between Brampton and Alconbury
- Widening the existing A14
- Improving junctions on the A14
- Improving Huntingdon Town centre
- Building new local access roads

The scheme will boost the local economy, cut journeys by 20 minutes, enhance national economic growth, connect communities, improve the environment and create a positive legacy for the region.
